## **Entry Process**

Entries must be done online via our Online Entry system. Coaches can access the online entry system by going to the 'Upcoming Events' page on our website [www.pttiming.com](http://www.pttiming.com)

Coaches who have established a login for our website during a previous Cross Country Season or Track Season will NOT need to re-establish a new login.

## **Entry Deadline**

The deadline for entries will be **two days prior to the event at noon**, unless specific arrangements are made in advance. Entries will open one week prior to the entry deadline.

**Teams that fail to meet the deadline will be charged a late fee of \$50, which must be paid prior to the start of meet in order for their entries to be accepted.**

Late Fee exceptions can be made but are solely at the discretion of the PTT on-site staff member.

## **Additions/Changes/Substitutions:**

Because we only have a limited number of chips available, we can not always assure that we can make additions, other than 'Scratch & Replace' changes at the meet. Moving athletes from one race to another is also acceptable. Coaches must report 'race changes' to the PTT Staff member on site to ensure the athletes are coded correctly in the system.

## **Chip Distribution:**

At the beginning of the meet, each school will receive a bag of chips which contains a roster of their entered athletes that specifies which athlete receives which chip. The chips are labeled with numbers that correspond to the number on the Print-out. The roster will also list what race the athlete was entered in by their coach (Varsity, JV, etc). Any changes need to be reported to the PTT Staff member to ensure the athletes show up correctly in the results.

**Chip Collection:**

Once the races are completed, the coaches will need to recollect all their assigned chips and hand them in using the bag they were given. The host school will need to provide workers to Count, collect, and replace the chips on the Velcro banners we provide.

There is a \$50 fee for each unreturned chip, so ensuring every team turns in all their chips is very important. The PTT Staff member will provide the 'chip collectors' a list of schools and the total number of chips each school was issued, so they can 'check off' schools as the chips are returned. The number of chip collectors needed for a meet depends on the size of the meet. A rule of thumb is 1-2 chip collectors for every 500 athletes at the meet.

**Finish Line Area:**

The finish line should be no longer than 12' wide, as this is the standard length of the timing 'mats.' There should be about 4' roped off on either side of the finish line. This is to ensure that coaches carrying extra chips or athletes wearing chips from another race don't get too close to the timing mats. This is very important to keeping the accuracy of the results. Coaches should be instructed not to walk around the finish line area with their chips. In many cases we will setup a 'backup' set of mats behind the finish line as well. Having people to keep the finishing athletes moving all the way past the mats is not only important from a timing standpoint but it is also important to keep the finish area clear for other finishers.
